2. Subject to the exceptions in Children's Classes 22 and 23, all entries are to be owned by the exhibitor and be all the exhibitor's own work.
3. Classes 1-16 Entries to be grown by the exhibitor. The Committee has the right to verify this.
4. Classes 35 - 37 Clear glass jars to be used with no trade markings on jar or lid.
5. Exhibitors must provide all plates, containers etc. All exhibits **MUST** be completed **outside** the hall before being staged. **No responsibility can be accepted for any damage to containers etc.**
6. The Judges have the power to withhold prizes should there be insufficient entries or entries of insufficient merit.
7. All exhibitors allowed only **one** entry per class.
8. All entries to be staged between 9am and 10.20am on the day of the Show so judging can start.
9. No exhibitors' names should be visible on entries.
10. Prizes will be presented at 4.15pm
11. No exhibits to be removed before 4.30pm.

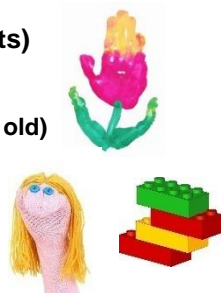
